CONCERT PIANIST RAYMOND JACKSON VISITS BEHREND AND PERFORMS AT BRUNO'S

Professor of music at Howard University in Washington D.C., Raymond Jackson began his music career in Providence, RI. Beginning at age five, Jackson received piano instruction which led to a skill in playing the organ.

His knowledge of music at an early age inspired a career as a concert pianist, recording artist, teacher, musical scholar and researcher, lecturer, clinician, and adjudicator.

Jackson attended the Juilliard School in New York City where he earned a Bachelor of Science, Master of Science, and Doctor of Musical

Arts Degrees. He has also been the recipient of numerous awards including the Marguerite Long International Piano Concour in Paris.

Such achievements have earned him the distinction of being the first African-American, first musician, and first person from his native state to be elected into the Rhode Island Heritage Hall of Fame.

On February 25th, Raymond Jackson will be performing at Behrend in the Bruno's Cafe at 8:30. Come out and show your support for Mr. Jackson.

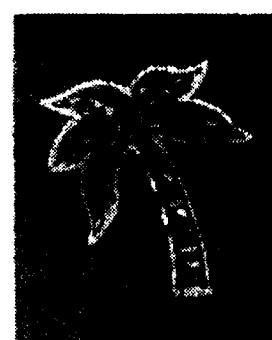
