it the last regular meeting of the Parnassus Honor Society of the Hazleton Eaupus the constitution of that organization was amended. Because an honor society reflects the character of its school, these changes should be of the utmost interest to each student.

In brief the amendments have made eligibility for membership open to students 1) having completed one or more semesters of college work, 2) having a minimum all-college average of 2.80 with no grade below a \underline{C} , 3) participating actively in at least two activities, and having at least 8 activity points by the end of the second semester, 12 by the end of the third, and 16 by the end of the fourth.

Eligibility for pledgeship for first semester students is open to those wen and women who in the judgement of the faculty are of good character, who have a minimum all-university average of 2.80, who have no grade below a C, and who participate actively in at least two activities, and who earn at least 4 activity points.

Furthermore a Parnaceus Advisory Committee has been instituted to examine the academic record of each candidate for membership and pledgeship and to pass judgement on any faculty veto of a candidate.

Under the provisions of the new Parnassus constitution a member whose all-university average falls below the minimum average required for membership or whose activity points total falls below the required minimum shall be put on probation for one semester. If his average or points is not raised to the mini us required for sembership by the end of that period, the number shall be dropped from the society.
