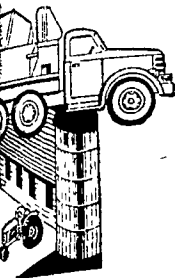

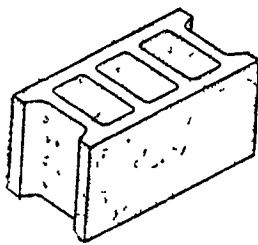

 unsettled, with heavy offer-
 ings. Fri total (to 10 a m)
 was 618,300 head, at 16-16-
 90.

Delmarva volume for the
 week was 3,152,000 head
 opening Monday at 17-17 3/4,
 dropping 1/4 to 1/2 cent daily
 to close.

Broiler-feed ratio for the
 week ending July 10, was
 off to 35, with broiler aver-
 age up to 17.68 from 17.38,

and feed up from \$96 to
 \$100.

Georgia closed with esti-
 mated slaughter of 2,215,000
 head for Fri & Sat. Geo. Ex-
 change had 649,100 offerings
 Thursday, sold 438,300 at
 143 - 146 primary range.
