per cent actually being sold through the Exchange Five times 80 million lbs is 400 million—times three-fourths cent per lb—\$3 million added to the state's poultry producers' income Not bad for an organiza- tion of local farmers, with one full-time employee No one can say exactly of course, just how much added income the Exchange has meant to county and state farmers. But, the above figures give you food for thought It is quite possible that the total value to the state's farm economy of the Exchange is more than \$4 million But by any standards, on Sept 17, when the Exchanges Fifth Anniversary is observ- ed, the investment of time and cash by a relatively few Lancaster County poultry- men will already have paid handsome dividends for the state
