CONGRESS.

As the Governor has failed to sign the new apportionment bill the members of the next Congress will be elected from the old district, with the addition of two Congressmen from the State at large.

Judge Scofield who has so ably represented the district during the last decade has signified his irrevocable determination to retire from Congressional life at the end of the present Congress. We regret this exceedingly, as no living man could have represented the district more to the satisfaction of the people.

Then it will devolve upon the Republicans of the district to select a man to be elected next October to fill the place. We should put forward our best man. It may be early to name a candidate, but it seems to us not entirely inopportune to express preferences, in order to fully bring out the views of the party before the time arrives to make nominations.
