THE MAY ALDINE is as fresh and beautiful as the month it represents; filled to the brim with choice flowers of art and literature. The engravings, which in this superb monthly seem to have reached the highest point of perfection, are beautiful beyond anything heretofore seen in an illustrated magazine. John S. Davis opens the number with a full-page picture, "The Dying Hound," which is one of his best efforts, a strong work, showing that it is a study from real life. J. D. Woodward contributes three large and spirited drawings of scenes in Florida, one of the most beautiful and picturesque States in the Union. The first picture of the series is a deliciously cool view of the famous Silver Spring, which boils up from the earth; the second picture is a handsome full-page illustration of the mouth of the St. John's River, showing the ruins of the old light-house, a grove of palm trees, etc.; the third picture is a wild and dreamy view of a Florida hummock, one of those strange emerald islands in the midst of a desert of sands. Two other handsome and interesting pictures are "A Retriever," after Deiker, and "The Bashful Lover," by J. M. Burfield. "Up Springs the Lark," is the title of a charming little view, exceedingly appropriate for spring time. John Howes has a full-page picture, striking for its boldness, called the "Hemlocks of Otsego," showing a group of those great trees upon the shores of that famous lake. "The New Capitol at Hartford, Conn., is finely executed drawing of the large and ornate building now in process of erection at Hartford, at the cost of several millions of dollars. The last illustration in this number is an excellent portrait of Max Strakosch, the impresario, so well known in connection with the Italian opera in this country. The literary contents of the May *Aldine* are of greater variety and excellence than usual. Annie Herbert opens the number with a long and musical poem called "My Round Tower in the West"; Kate Putnam Osgood tells the story of "A Little Fool"; Henry Morford has a touching poem, "The Sightless Eye"; Jacob L. Mayer gives a very interesting account of "A Visit to Erckmann-Chatrian"; A. H. Cady tells in a new form "The Old, Old Story"; Mrs. L. M. Blinn sings of "The Beautiful By and By"; and S. F. Hopkins, of London, has a long and wonderfully entertaining account of "An English Spring." Frederick R. Marvin has a poem called "My Earthly Love"; Fenno Douglas tells the dramatic story of "Duskie"; The Dying Hound;" "Flight through Florida;" "The Retriever;" "The Bashful Lover;" "The Hemlocks of Otsego;" "The New Capitol at Hartford, Conn.;" "Literature;" "The Water Color Exhibition;" "Wagner's Lohengrin;" "Max Strakosch" and the "Drama."
