Bradford to Richburg. AN IRON ROAD TO THE NEW OIL FIELD.

W. W. Brown, Esq., returned from Harrisburg Saturday, having secured a charter for the Bradford, Richburg & Cuba railroad, which is designed to give this direct communication with the new oil field.

The distance from Bradford to Richburg has not been fully determined, but will be long. New York State parties have interested themselves in that end of the line and will push it through.

The distance from Bradford to the State line is about twenty miles and the line passes through a country much more favorably for railroad purposes than that about Bradford and the portion in New York traverses a fine agricultural district.

It is impossible at this early day to give full details of the scheme as the general plan may be modified in a measure. Engineers are already at work between Eldred and Ceres and ground was broken yesterday at the former place.

Fifty men are grading and more will be put on as soon as the choice between the Borden and Oswayo routes has been determined on. On the 5th instant a charter was granted to other projectors for the Eldred & Wellsville railroad.

It has often been suggested that there is as much need for a society for the suppression of pernicious literature as there is for one of which Anthony J. Comstock is the efficient agent, and these two cases coming so close together may help enforce the suggestion.—Phila. Press.
