WASHINGTON, May 22.—The postmaster general, in response to a resolution of the house to-day sent a letter to the speaker, in which he recommends that postage on second class matter (papers and magazines) be abolished. He also stated that fourth class (merchandise) is carried at a loss to the government, and if the government is to be taxed for transportation of either class it should be for the second class instead of the fourth.
