Major-General Meade.—The Boston Pilot asserts that the veteran commander of the army of the Potomac is a Roman Catholic, and many of the copperhead journals assert that he is a Democrat. We presume that in either case it would not make any difference in the value of his services. It is well, however, that the truth should be known. Gen. Meade is a Philadelphian. His family reside here. His sons have been drafted here. He is a member of the Protestant Episcopal church, and his family holds a weekly service in their parsonage. He has been in regular attendance in Saint Paul's church since Meade's relations in life, as in politics, have been Whig. His family were all Whigs, and though opposed to the anti-slavery agitation before the war broke out the General has since become an earnest supporter of the whole policy of the national administration, like George Grant, Bowditch, and other conservatives.—*North American*.

The Interview Between Rosecrans And Vallandigham.—The Dayton (Ohio) Journal relates the following appos of Vallandigham:

"When Vallandigham arrived at Murfreesboro, Gen. Rosecrans went to see him. I wanted to see you," said the general—"want to see you, sir." "I am sorry to see you, but you had a rascallish way of talking, and bringing down the subject rather abruptly—and bringing down the subject which is a conspicuous feature of his greatness when he is in terrible earnest"—he said—"Vallandigham, don't you come back here. You—you—Vallandigham! I'll beat—! and may God forgive me for the expression—I'll beat—! I don't know you!" People will be pleased to remember that the General says he "never blenched but in sometimes scenes."

The Tinted Blotter has information relative of the alleged withdrawal of Vallandigham, and says that the rumor is that he is to be presented, requiring a belief that in case of his election, he will cooperate fully with the national government. An anonymous letter to the editor of the *Journal*, who has the exclusive right to give place to any man who will make that pledge.—"We have, yes, the blade,"—evidently what satisfies us that he is to be presented.—"I am sorry to see you, sir, on the ticket with Vallandigham, who was among the most zealous in inciting the mobocracy, and who could not get the places they now occupy, but for their support of him."

In Jackson county, Ohio, Morgan stole 200 horses, and the Union forces appropriated 45, valued in the aggregate at \$100,000. The horses and mules, however, taken by Morgan, was valued at \$16,000. The damage done to the Portsmouth and Newark Railroad will run up to the total of about \$50,000.

ED TO PICKLE ORANGES.—Fill a metal or porcelain kettle with small white onions, throw in a handful of salt, add a quantity of the humanity of oranges, have it all well boiled on the fire a few minutes, then strain through a coarser cloth and spread them upon a large table, rub them with salt, then lay them in a jar, add a layer of onions, put them in jars, add some blades of mace, some whole pepper and cloves, fill up the jars with cold vinegar, cork and cement them. This is an easy and simple receipt.

ED THE MILITARY COURT.—Poured off a barrel of soap bubbles on Pennsylvania Jane, a quarter of a pound of beeswax. Half a pound of resin. Poured the resin fine, and melt the resin and beeswax together in some old iron vessel. When they are melted, pour in a quantity of water, make a paste, and add a quantity of the dissolved soap bubbles. Dip your bottle necks into the hot emulsion after they are well corked, and in a few minutes the cement will dry.

This brick dust must be powdered as fine as possible, and passed through a coarse or fine marble.

THE French in Mexico.
SAN FRANCISCO, Aug. 18.—The steamer *St. Louis* has arrived here, with news via Alameda, San Francisco, and of July 23d. General Forey was issued discharge orders.

The French Mexican newspapers urge the recognition of the Southern Confederacy. They state that France will recognize it. Mexican jealousy and prejudices are being provoked against the United States. The Government paper says the northern States are in favor of Juarez, while the Confederates are for a Mexican monarchy, and everything looks to the immediate recognition of the Confederacy by Mexico.

The guerrillas were fighting on the road leading to the city of Mexico. The Mexicans make no prisoners but slay all they capture. They wage a war of extermination. Numerous assassinations have taken place in the capital of persons sympathizing with the French.

The Triumvirate Government was daily impriating and shooting persons who refused to take the oath of allegiance to the Emperor.

Mexicans have been publicly flogged for refusing to supply quarters to French officers. One Mexican lady, named Rosina Rubio, had received two hundred lashes for refusing to receive French officers into her house. Her husband offered to pay a fine equal to her weight in silver, rather than submit to this indignity, but Gen. Forey insisted on making an example of her.
