SUIT AGAINST THE GOVERNMENT ROBBED, DUL HAWK.—On Monday last suit was entered in the Supreme Court of Dist. Columbia against A. J. McConaughay, Surg. Gen. U. S., to recover \$450,000 dollars, the amount alleged the government has been defrauded of by his blanket purchase from W. A. Stevens, and supplies from John Wyeth & Bro., \$50,000 being the amount in the first case and \$100,000 in the second.

ENTER FROM SHERMAN.

NASHVILLE, Sept. 5.

News from General Sherman's army to-day reports the enemy lost 2,000 killed and wounded. We captured 5,000 prisoners. Among them is a Brigadier General. A large amount of material was captured. The army is in full possession of Atlanta. The river is four feet and rising.
