Over the past two weeks, the golf team has fared significantly well by posting low scores in three tournaments.

On September 24, the team traveled to Case Western Reserve in Ohio, for the university's fall tournament.

Linksters ended up number four out of ten teams, with an overall score of 345.

Leading medalist for the team was Jamie Neumaier with an 85. One stroke behind him was Jake Neitz and Jamie Baker. Keith Camp came in with an 88, and Steve Seidler shot a 90.

The Mercyhurst College Tourney, at Lakewood Country Club, followed on September 27.

Although they posted an overall lower score than at the last tournament, they only managed to take ninth place out

of 11. Once again, Jamie Neumaier led the way with an 81.

The biggest highlight of the season so far was the outstanding play of Freshman David Koester at the Edinboro University Fall Tournament on September 30.

Head Coach Herb Lauffer said, "Significant was the fact that David shot a 77, and with scores in the 70s our overall score had gone down."

The overall team score for this match was 326.

Lauffer also said, "Last year other coaches were looking at us as just another team, but now they're realizing we are doing better, and they're starting to recognize us."

"We've shot very respectable scores, and if we can continue to save ourselves some strokes, we can really move up in the standings considerably," Lauffer concluded.
