Fifty-two men's teams entered the hunt for the 3 on 3 title. The teams were placed into 13 divisions and the winners of each division went to the championship bracket.

The Schick Super Hoops 3 on 3 tournament ended a strong fall intramural season.

Intramural Coordinator Rob Wittman was pleased with participation this fall. "Overall, it (fall participation) was pretty good. It was up in some sports and down in some."

Wittman continued, "I don't have any official numbers yet, but they should be just as good as last year and last year broke records."

The fall point tallies are close in two divisions, Fraternity and Independents, while the races in the other two divisions, Residence Halls and Women, are all but over.

Kappa Delta Rho leads the Fraternity division with 1,111 points, while Delta Chi (1,026), Sigma Tau Gamma (953) and Sigma Kappa Nu (950) are not far behind.

Nasty Assassins of Love lead the Independent Division with 796 points. Perry peckers (723) is a close second.

Lawrence First Floor East is running away with the residence hall Division. They have a comfortable 255 point lead over Niagra third floor.

Weimer's Women have a 640 point lead over Perry Powerhouse in the Women's Division.

The intramural schedule starts up right away in the new year with 5 vs 5 basketball. Sign-ups end December 10.
