entertainment and it never seemed worth worrying about.

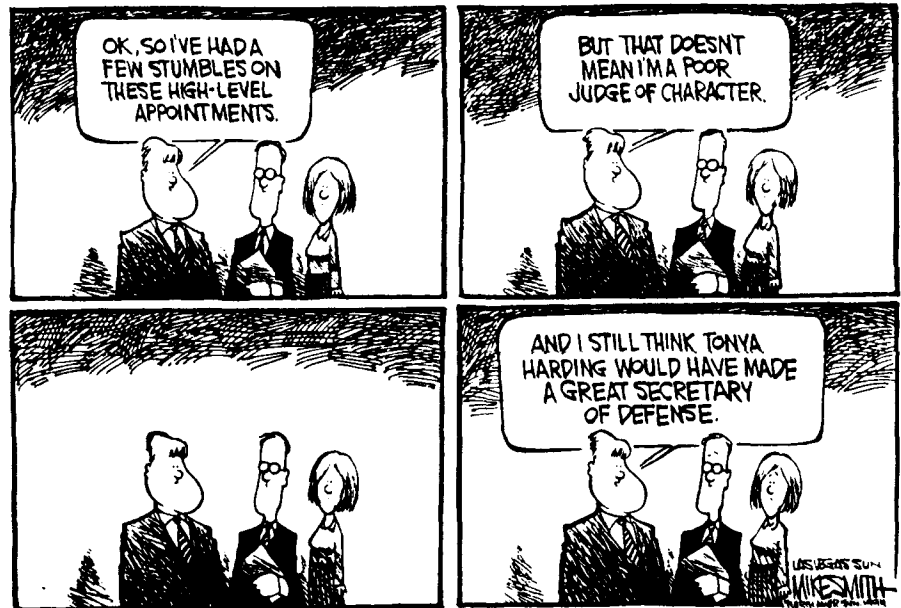
Last Friday I went to watch "Glory." I lost count of the number of times the film stopped, sometimes as many as three times within two minutes.
