Johnson, who is the fourth coach to lead the Lions in a year hopes that he will be around long enough to "cause a little controversy in the Athletic Department."

Reber to receive ultimate honor

"Miracles do happen, even to me, now it will also be shared with the Behrend community." In a press conference at Erie Hall, Director of Student Activities, David Shields, announced the plans to build Reber Stadium here at Penn State-Behrend.

Funding for the stadium will not come from the students pockets, but from Shields'. Last week he won the Pennsylvania State Super 7 Lotto for 55.6 million dollars.

When asked where he bought the ticket Shields said, "I found the ticket at Jiggles Night Club while dating with Dean Lilley."

Also in the press conference, it was announced that Penn State-Behrend will have a football team playing in the stadium at the beginning of the 1996 school year.

"We have met with one prospective coach, and he plans to be here in the coming weeks," Shields said.

Collision insiders, Keith McFall, Matthew D. Cissne and Joseph E. Mottillo have found out the secret coach will be none other than Nittany Lion Head Coach Joe Paterno.

The total cost of the stadium is not yet known. One item billed to Shields is that of a new 1994 Ford Probe, which has been seen speeding on campus with Emmy Arnett and women's softball coach Paul Benim. This incident is under investigation.

Shields also announced that along with Behrend football, the NFL is looking to play preseason games and also possibly the 1998 Super Bowl in Reber stadium.

NFL commissioner Paul Taglibule did say, however, that even if the Bills do get there they will not play at Reber Stadium. This comes as a big relief to many people of the Behrend and Erie community.
