Arnett claims second Athlete of the Week title in two years

"She does everything hard and at full speed, and that is the only way she knows how to do things," said Head Softball Coach Paul Benim of sophomore catcher, Emmy Arnett.

Arnett earned Athlete of the Week honors by going 6-7 from the plate with a double and four RBIs, scoring 5 runs, and swiping three bases against Geneva in a double-header last week. That performance raised her batting average to .385.

She leads the team in steals with 14 and runs scored with 15. She will soon break the record for most steals in a season set by Darcie Bradley last year with 18.

As for what she feels she contributes to the team Arnett said, "I do what I can to help the team."

Benim added, "The bottom line is, deep down inside she wants to win and she'll do whatever she has to do to get the job done."

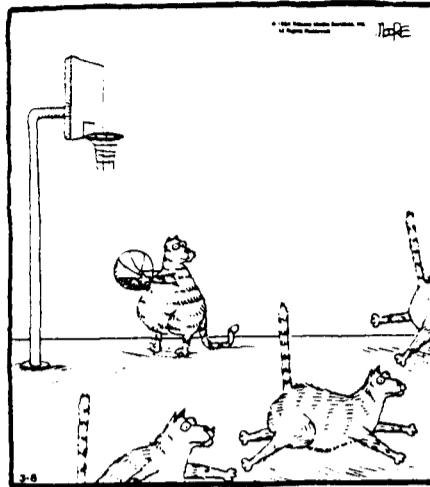

She was originally recruited to Behrend by Jenepher Banker, the former women's basketball coach, to play basketball.

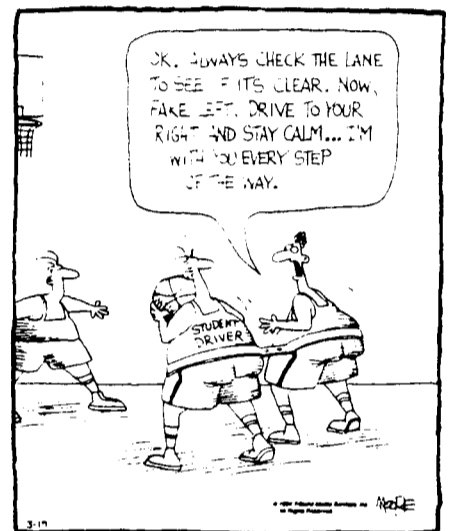
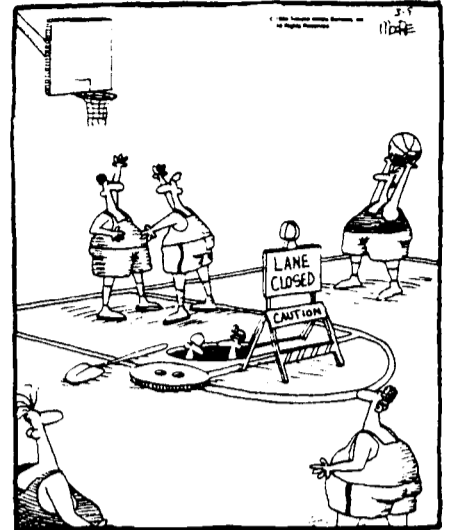
She has set her goals high for the team this year. "I want to win the NCAA Division III Tournament."
