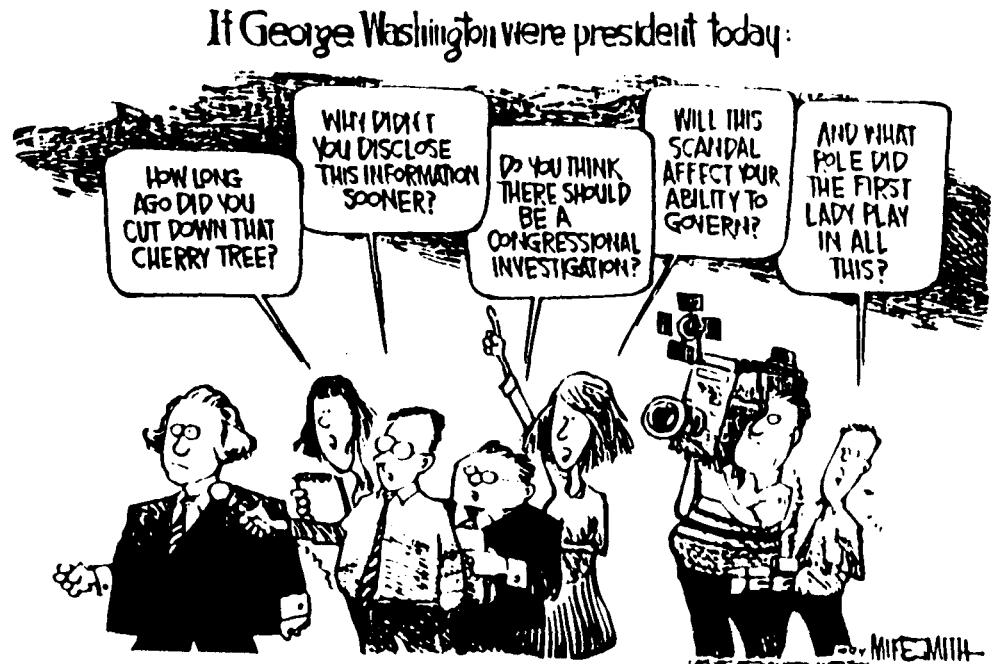


## Editorial...
