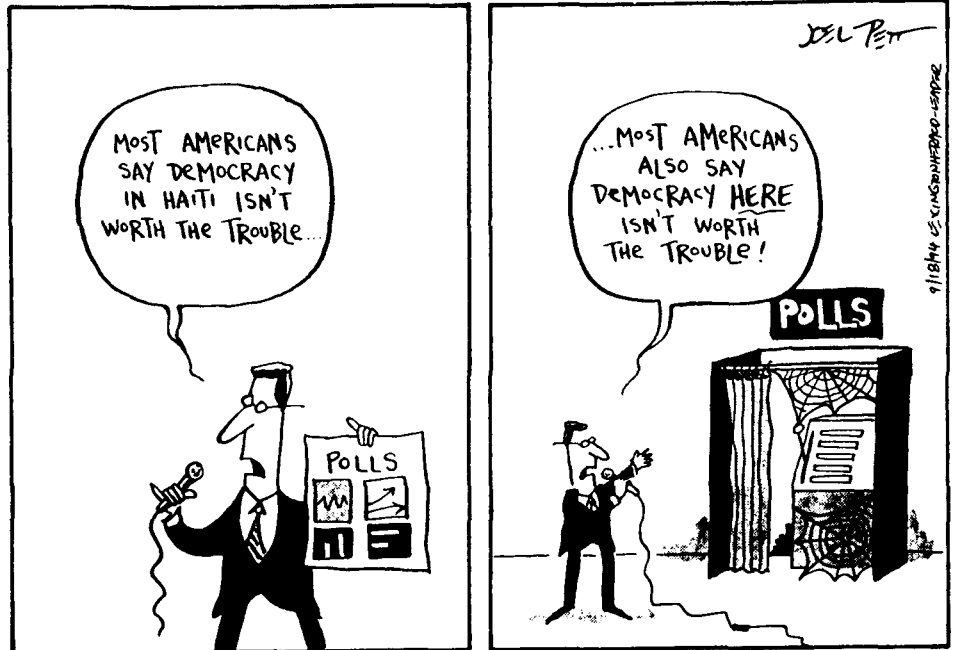


# Editorial...
