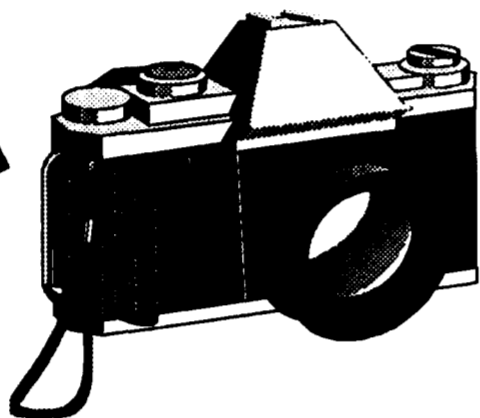

In the first of the 1997-98 Penn-State Behrend Open House Nights in Astronomy series, *Dr. Roger Knacke* will present "Is There Life on Mars?" on Thursday, September 25 at 7:30 p.m. in the Reed Lecture Hall. His lecture will summarize the results of the recent Pathfinder mission to Mars. Dr. Knacke is a professor of Physics and the head of the Division of Science at Behrend.

In celebration of *Hispanic Heritage Month*, Behrend will present a festival of Cuban folk music and dance on Monday, September 29 at

7:00 p.m. in the Reed Commons. The event will include Cuban folk singer *Lazaro Ross*, and the *Cucalambe Cuban Folk Dance Ensemble*. In addition to folk music and dance, the presentation will include contemporary Latin dance music.
