The Open House Nights in Astronomy will continue on Thursday, October 30 at 7:30 p.m. when Dr. Keith S. Noll presents "Beyond Planet X." Noll, an astronomer at the Space Telescope Science Institute, will discuss a new class of objects dwelling at the edge of our solar system. His presentation will take place in the Reed Lecture Hall.

Thomas' presentation continues the 1997-98 Penn State Behrend Speaker Series which is sponsored by the Office of Student Activities.

The Behrend Foreign Film Series continues with "The Silences of the Palace" on Monday, October 27 at 7:00 p.m. in the Reed Lecture Hall. Winner of six major international film awards, this 1994 Tunisian film is a visually lush and moving exploration of the challenges confronting North African women in the face of "centuries-old traditions of sexual subordination." The film is in Arabic with English subtitles.

The reception will be hosted by Provost and Dean Dr. John M. Lilley and by Penn State President Dr. Graham Spanier. Cameras are welcome at the award reception, but Waterhouse will be available for a brief news conference on Friday, October 24 at 10:40 a.m. in the Science Building, room 143. At 11:00 a.m. Mr. Waterhouse will teach a class to Behrend business students in room 101 of the same building. Reporters will be welcome in the classroom.

The Honorable Judge Michael T. Joyce will present a lecture, "Legal Education and the Crisis of the Judiciary," on Thursday, October 23 from 12:15 p.m. to 1:00 p.m. in Reed 113. The presentation is being sponsored by the Behrend Political Science program. Joyce attended Behrend in the early seventies and frequently returns to participate in alumni soccer matches.
