His family said that though Brozell suffered from diabetes he never let that get him down, and that they hope he serves as an example of how to overcome obstacles in life.

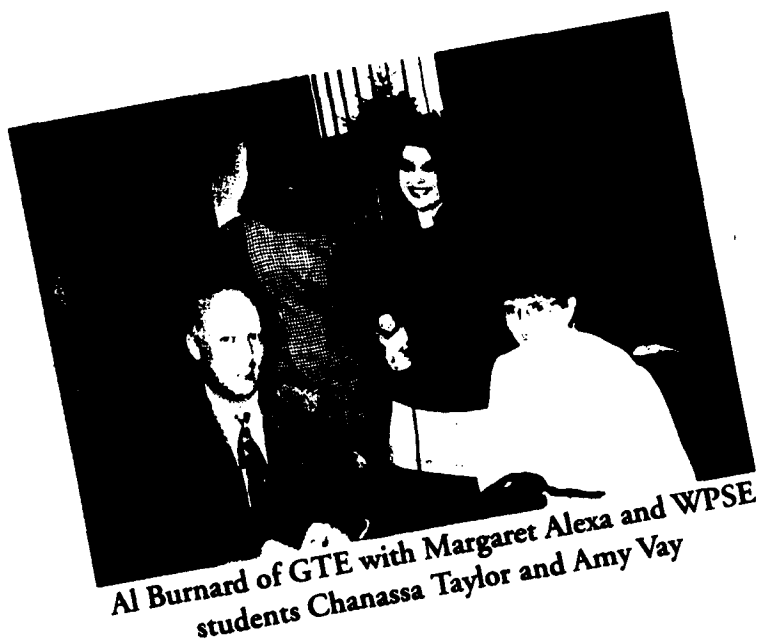

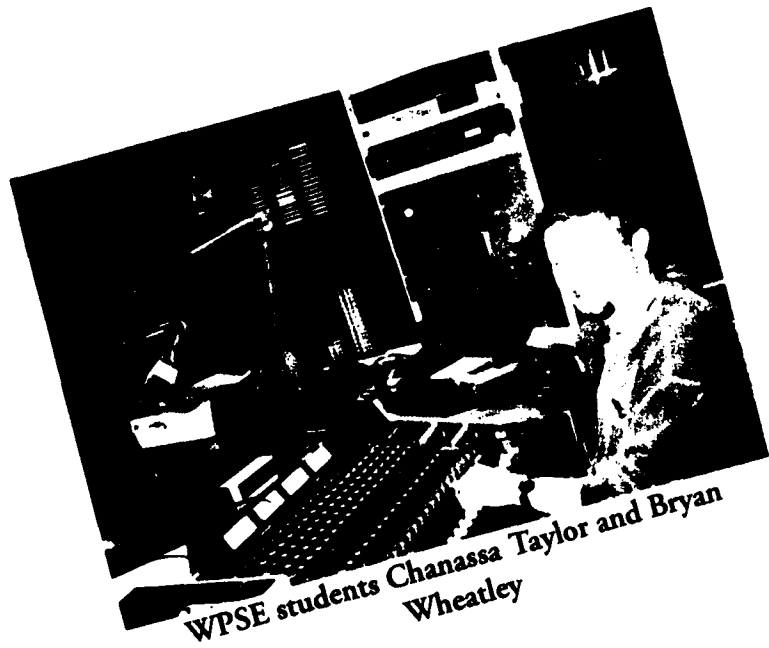

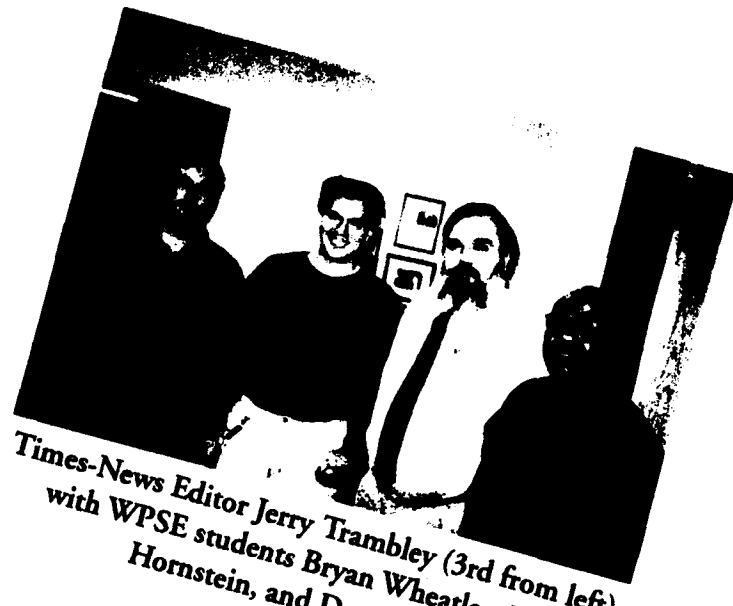
