facility was not permissible under present zoning. The area where the Kanty Prep building is located has B-1 zoning, which allows for hospitals or medical or dental clinics, according to Hall. Much of the testimony focused on the definition of hospital, and whether Gateway could be considered a hospital. Hall stated, "it was a hospital, but it was more than a hospital." He described it as "a hybrid of a hospital, a rehabilitation center and a corrections facility."


tions is: do people respond differently and does it matter? She then went on to say that it does matter if you smoke. In time, smoking takes away the sense of smell.

women are about even with their sense of smell.


