earns 4th seed  
at AMCC  
Championship*

The Penn State Behrend women's volleyball team cruised to a 3-1 victory against Penn State branch rival Altoona on Friday, October 22. The women are now 5-5 in their conference and 12-16 overall. The team followed the lead of co-captains Mary Good and Tanya Deats. Good finished the night with 11 kills and 13 digs. Deats continued her solid play contributing 12 kills and 2 blocks. Sophomore Sarah Peterson also played a good game with 3 kills and 15 digs.

The women's next game ended in defeat against a tough Pitt-Bradford team. The team lost in 3 straight close games. Behrend played well, but couldn't quite gain command of the game. The entire team contributed to keep it a tight match. Freshman Karen Walters had a tremendous outing, recording 42 assists and 12 digs. Junior Mary Good pitched in 12 kills and 25 digs.

Behrend will enter the AMCC tournament as the fourth seed on November 5-6. They will face the number one seed, Frostburg. The winner of that will play the winner of the La Roche-Pitt-Bradford game and the losers will go home. The women have played Frostburg twice this season, both resulting in losses. Coach Cindy Jacobelli stated, "We look optimistically to the tournament. We have played two tough games against Frostburg and we have a feel for them." Sophomore Allison Millet added, "I think we have a good chance to win the AMCCs. I would like to see La Roche or Bradford again before the season is over." The Lady Spikers next match will be the last of the regular season. It is at home vs. Pitt-Greensburg on November 1.
