Carrie Nestor has been named this week's Food and Housing Athlete of the Week. She is the starting point guard for the women's basketball team. Nestor scored 10 points, dished out 9 assists and had three rebounds and steals in the 71-55 loss at Bethany. She led the Behrend Lions to the title at the Marietta Tournament with a 12 point, 5 assist, 4 rebound and 2 steal performance against CWR. In the championship game against Marietta she had 8 points, 7 assists and 3 rebounds. During the tournament she played in 78 of a possible 80 minutes and was nine of ten from the free-throw line.
