#### TEMPUS SUBMISSIONS CALL

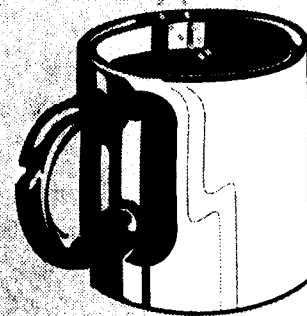
