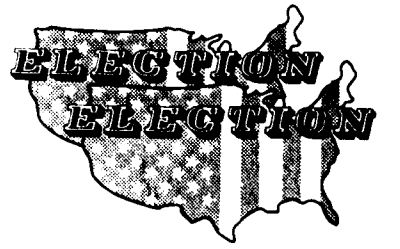

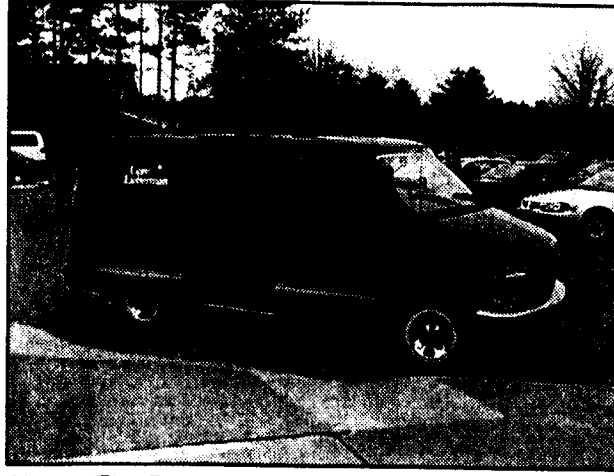

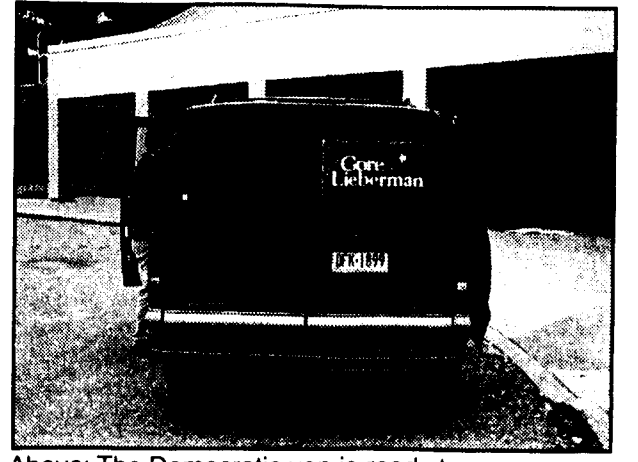
Above: The Republican van waiting for students so they could get out and vote.



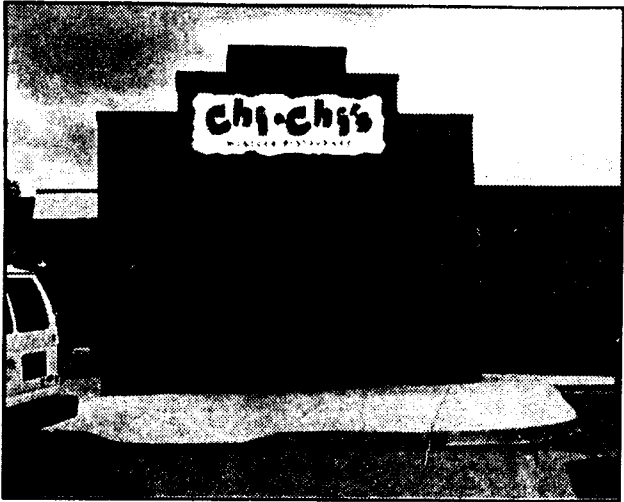
Above: The Republican van leaving to go to the polls.



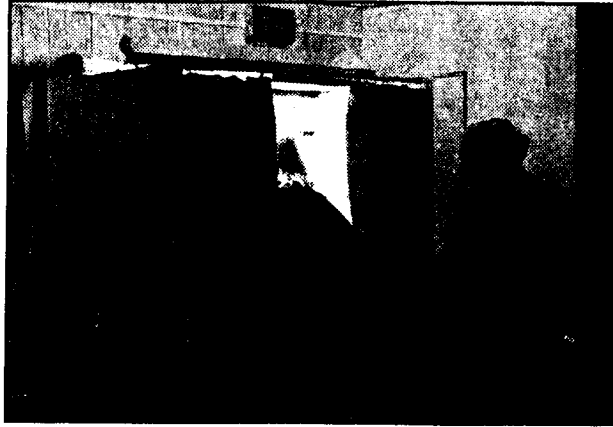
Above: The Democratic van has their doors open for students.



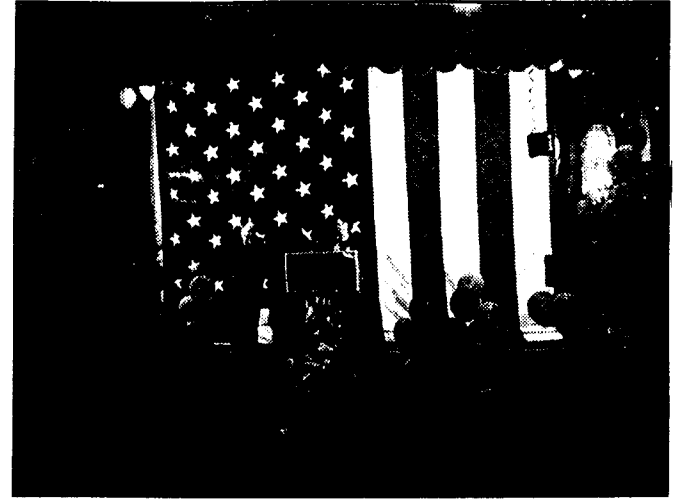

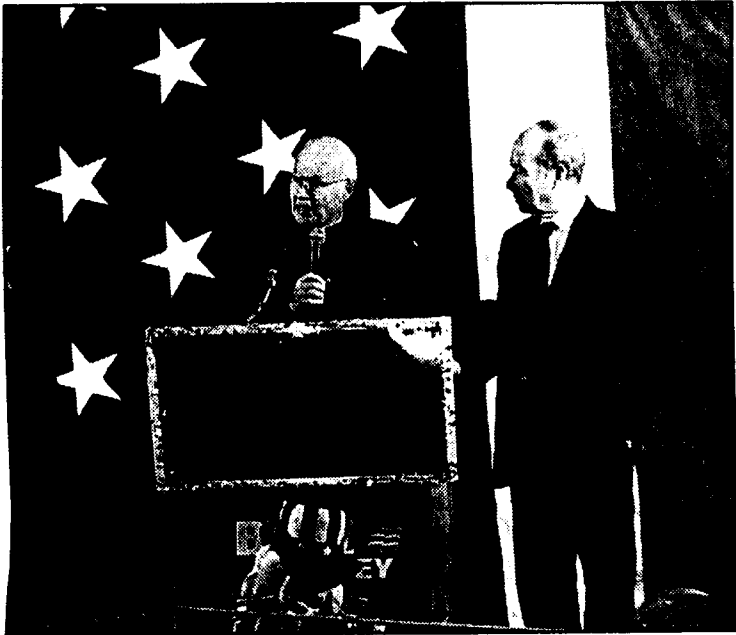

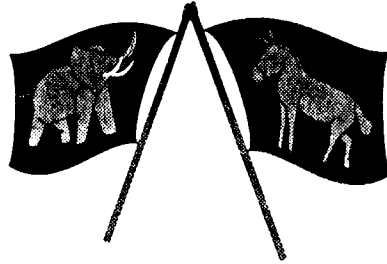

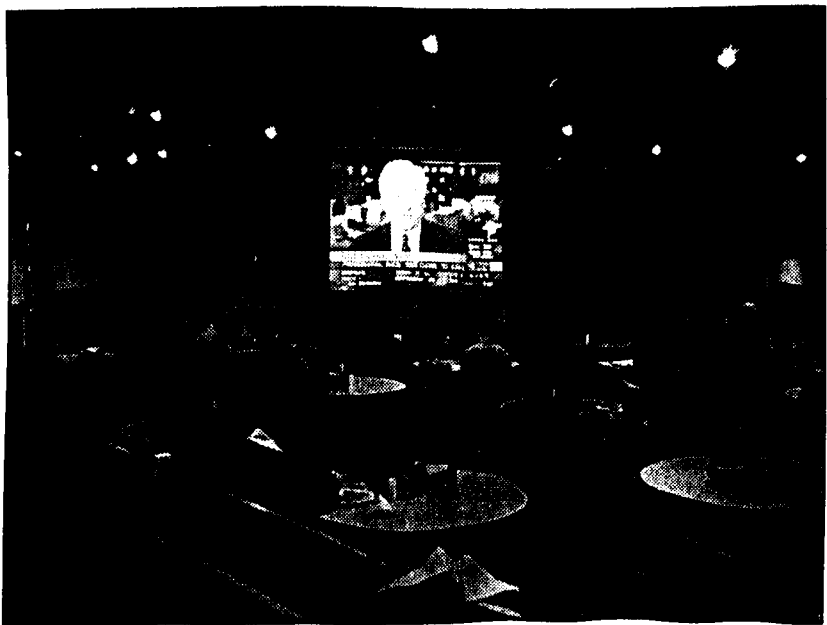

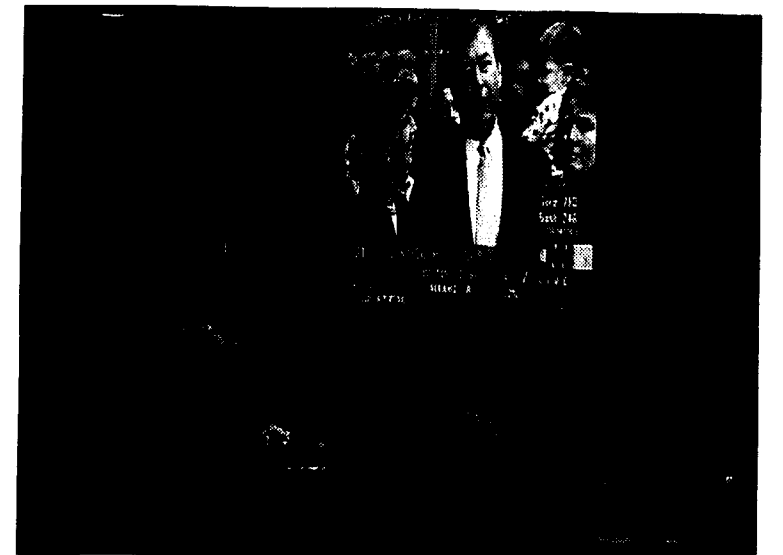
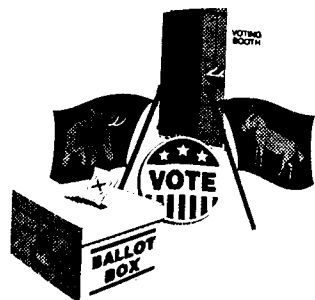
