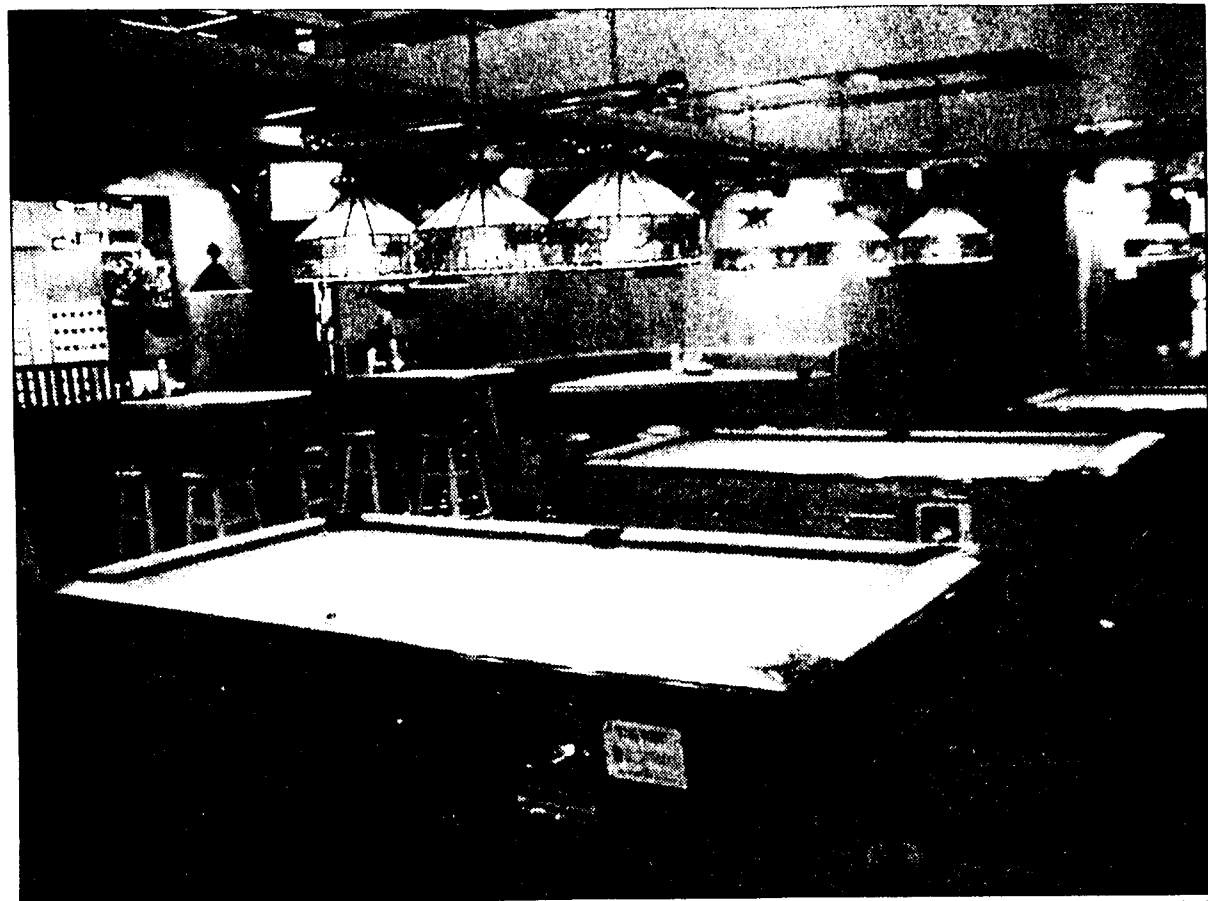


Hot Spots in Erie

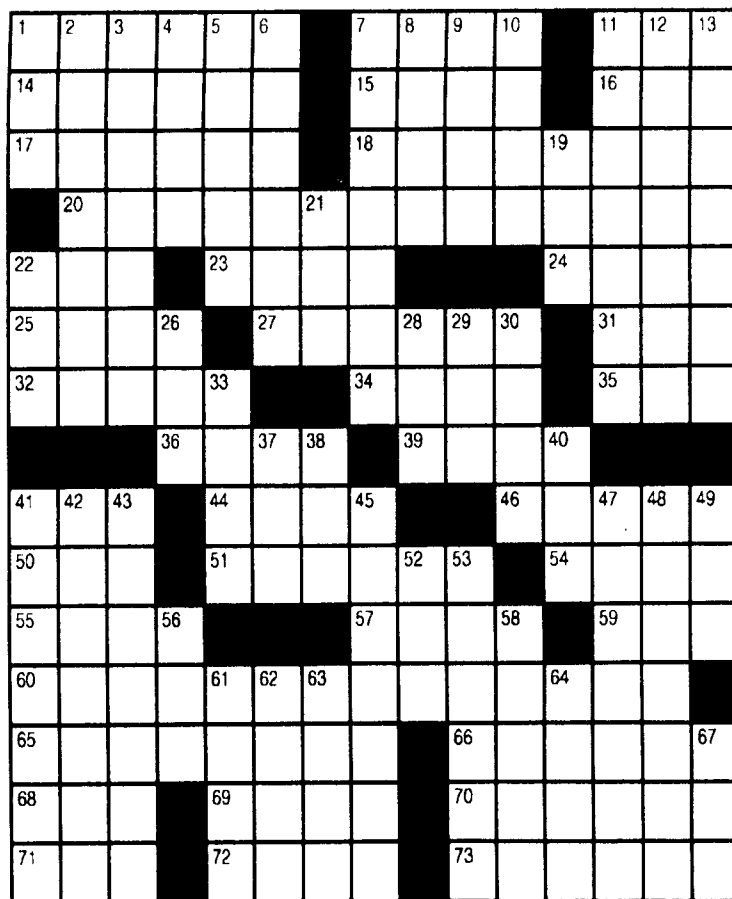
