## Peninsula Drive-In Theatre

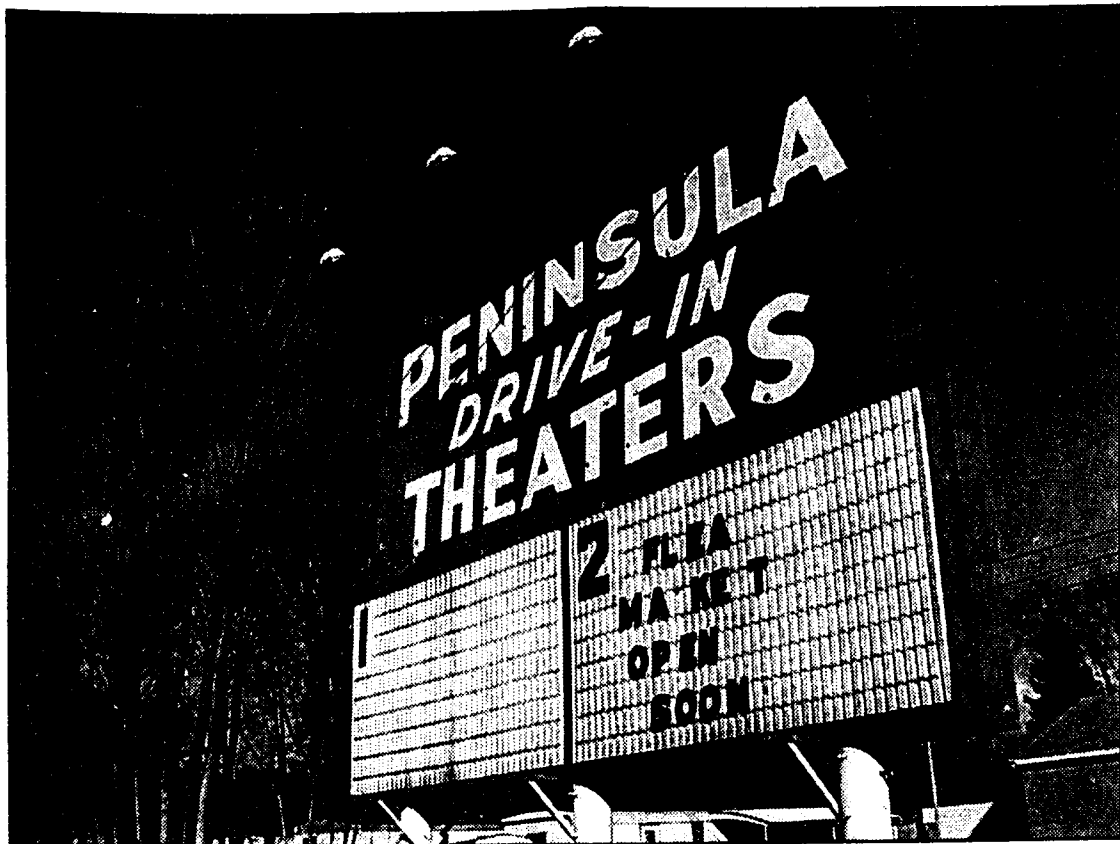

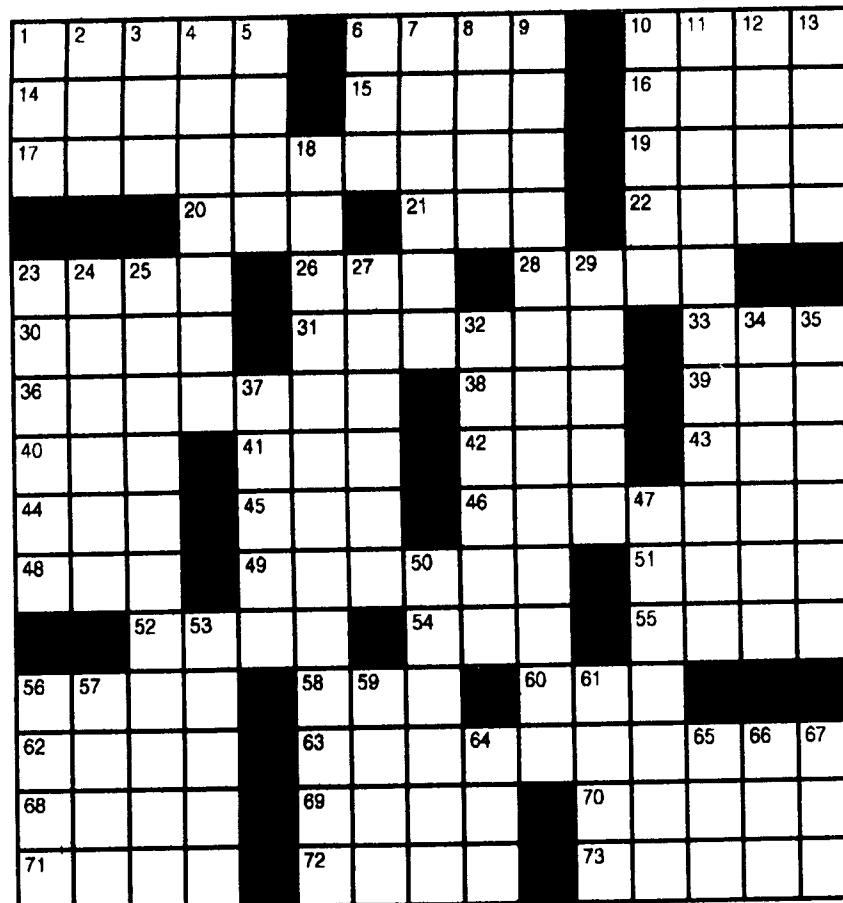

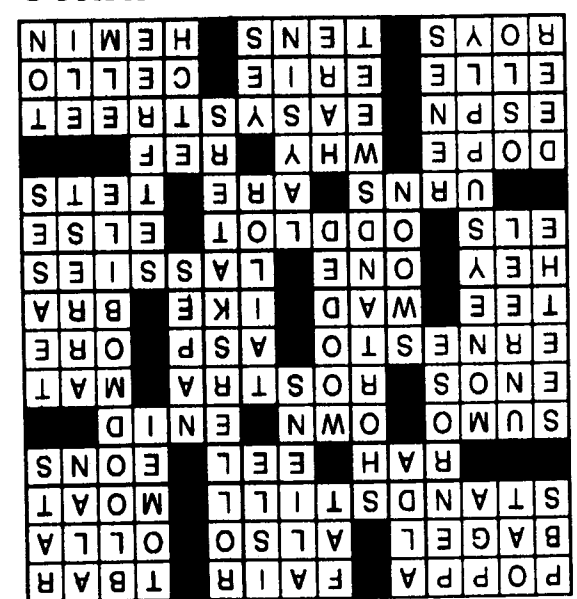
