

Behrend is recognizing National Depression Screening Day Oct. 3rd, outside Bruno's between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.

The goal of the event is to heighten awareness to the signs and symptoms of depression. Depression is a very severe, yet common disorder that affects both the body and mind. College students are particularly at risk. There will be an opportunity to fill out a screening form, which will be scored and reviewed with you by a mental health professional. In addition, there will be an opportunity to fill out a questionnaire on suicide if someone knows a person at risk. The forms are anonymous, and a number, not a name, will be used for identification purposes.
