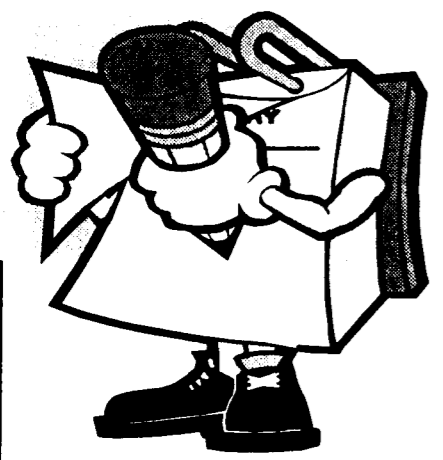

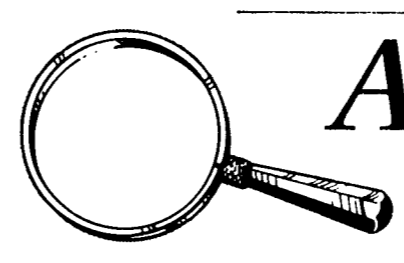


**Mark Your Calendars**
