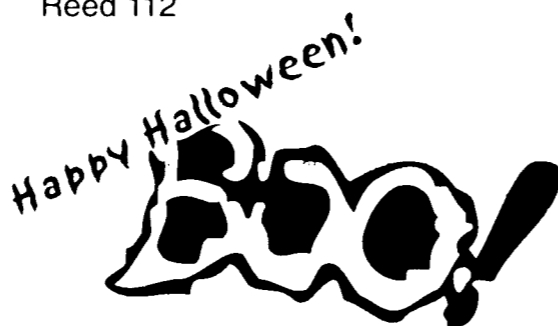

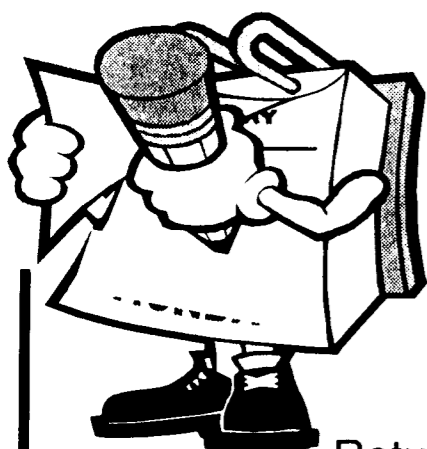

Returning Adult Student Organization

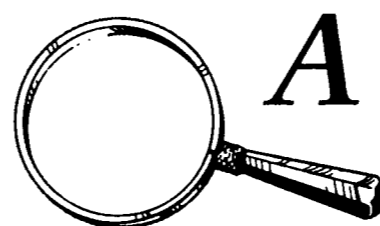
