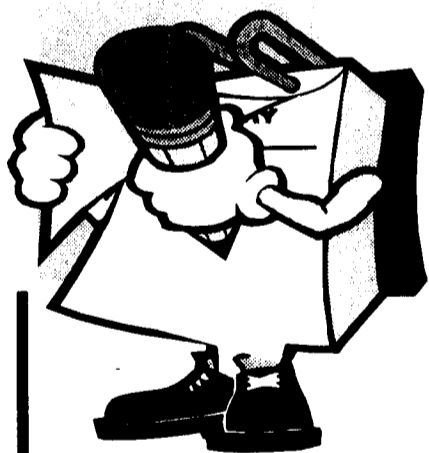

MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. 2002 CELEBRATION

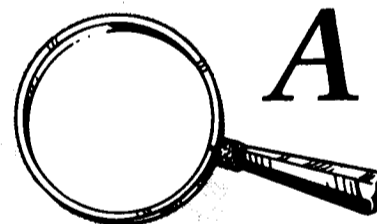
