



The 2002 SGA will have 11 vacant Senate seats, as well as a secretary position for the 2002-2003 school year. Candidates may run their own campaign, which will start on March 18 and will run until election day, which will be held on April 17 - 18. The 11 candidates with the most votes will earn a seat on the 2002-2003 Senate.

SGA elected Jacqueline Jackson and Scott Soltis to fill two empty Senate seats for the rest of the 2001-2002 school year. Jessi Dearolf replaces Katie Leary as the Panhellenic Council Representative.
