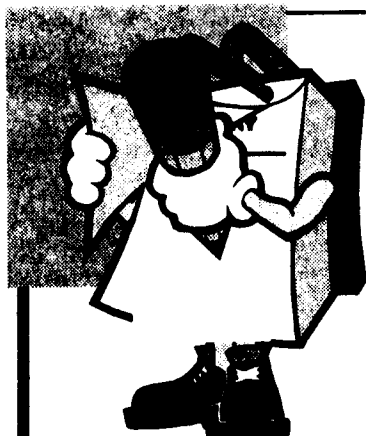

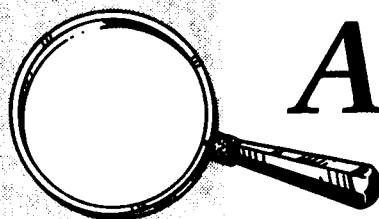
Mark Your Calendars
