

Beacon: What drew you to the sports program at Penn State Behrend?

Murphy: I went to Washington & Jefferson College from 1994-1998 and played against coach Niland and his basketball team back then. Even then I was really impressed with his style of coaching. That's the main reason why I came here, because my ultimate goal is to become a college basketball coach. [Now] I know a lot of good things about coaching and the program.

Beacon: What can you bring now to the golf and basketball programs?

Murphy: To be honest with you, this is my first year coaching golf, but I've been involved with coaching since I graduated from college. I was with the high school basketball team for a year and at Robert Morris University Division I program for two years. I feel like I have some coaching experience and I feel like I can bring a lot more to basketball than golf. But I think we'll

be very competitive in both sports.

Beacon: Does the golf team feel complete with the limited amount of practice they've had so far?

Murphy: We haven't had a practice yet. We just got done with tryouts this past week and we have our second meeting on Thursday. We start practice Friday and our next match the following Thursday. But I think they're excited about a new year and they're ready to get going and be as competitive as possible.

Beacon: Now you have a young team?

Murphy: They're a very young team. I think we have five guys returning from last year and I believe four of them are sophomores. Out of the five new guys I believe three of them are freshmen, one's a sophomore, and one's a junior. We'll definitely be young. Half the team wasn't even on the team last year. But they're good players. The scores came in from the week-end with the tryouts and they're pretty good.
