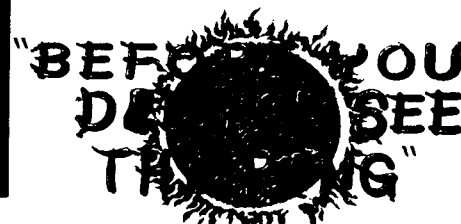

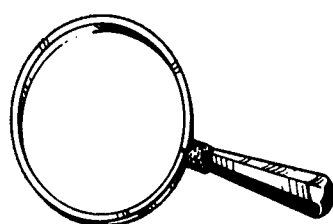
SGA Elections
