#### Women's water polo going to NCAA championships

In their third year of existence, Behrend will travel to California May 1-4 for the NCAA Water Polo Championships. The sixth-seeded Lions will take on secondseeded Pomona-Pitzer College in their first action of the tournament. Roundrobin play will continue against three-seed Claremont and seven-seed Macalaster. Sophomore Christine Williams is only a few goals shy of breaking the singleseason scoring record she set in 2002.



## Baseball wins AMCC regular season



Behrend clinched the AMCC regular-season title with a 9-3 record, 26-10 overall. The Lions are second in three out of four AMCC team statistics. Behrend players Mitch Reckner, Adam Best, Tim Stafford, and Tony Azzato place high among other AMCC players in individual statistics categories. Pitchers Brent Gabel and Ryan Seyler also are near the top in wins and ERA. The Lions host the AMCC tournament this weekend.

# Softball ends disappointing season

The Lions wrapped up a tough 2003 season with two losses against Bethany, 3-0 and 19-5. Behrend failed to qualify for the AMCC tournament, posting a dismal 4-18 record, 11-21 overall. The Lions finished fifth in the AMCC. Departing after several productive seasons with the Lions are senior captains Cheryl Peterson and Emily Allen, along with third basemen/catcher Erika Mack. Freshman pitcher Kim Raff found herself among the AMCC s best pitchers in her debut year. Raff averaged 3.29 strikeouts per seven innings, striking out 41 batters on the year.
