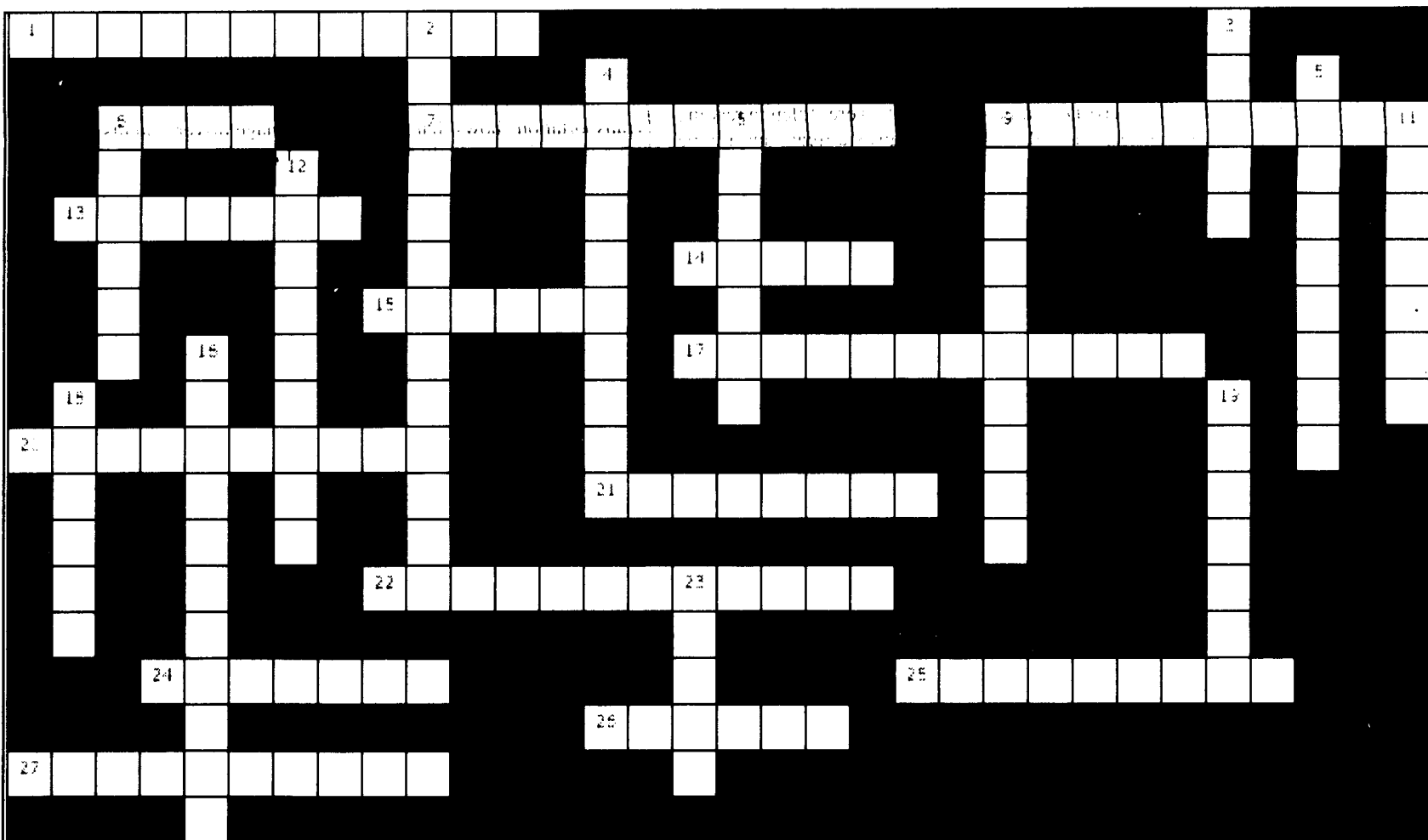
The Niedenberger and Kelecseny: '70s Music Edition
