## Protestant Campus Ministry hosts basket auction

The Protestant Campus Ministry (PCM) is auctioning themed baskets for a fundraiser from Nov. 30 through Dec. 5 at the Smith Chapel.

Claire Chadwick, Director of PCM, said that the baskets have been donated by individuals, local area churches, faculty, and staff.

According to Chadwick, the fundraiser is a silent auction where students, faculty, and

staff come to the Smith Chapel and write their bid down.

As of Thursday, five students wrote down a bid, yet Chadwick predicts that 20 students will bid by the Saturday deadline. She expects an increase in bidding due to the choir concert held at 8 p.m. on Saturday.

Chadwick anticipates raising around the same amount of money as last year, which was \$500.

"We plan on using the money for activities," Chadwick said. "We have activities going on all the time. On Sundays we have worship and then a dinner and discussion after the worship. We will also use [the money] for prayer and meditation held on Wednesdays."

Chadwick explained that the highest bidder for each basket will receive their particular basket the following week.

Each individual basket has its own theme and consists of items that relate to the specific theme. As of Thursday, the themes are finals, hunting, baking, chocolate, Mary Kay, Christmas, and soup. Chadwick said that the most popular basket will be the ticket basket, which includes tickets to the

"The Bell Valley Presbyterian Church donates the ticket basket," Chadwick said. "Last year it was estimated at \$450 and someone got it for \$75. So you can get some really good deals."

The PCM is not funded through Behrend, rather they

are a non-profit organization.

"We have churches that sponsor us," Chadwick said. "We also have to do other fundraisers on campus and in the community to raise money."

Along with Chadwick, the PCM board was involved with organizing the fundraiser. "On the board, we have 10-12

pastors and other administrators like Kris Torak (Director of Student Activities), Bill McLean (Lecturer in Speech Communication), and Zach Irwin (Associate Professor of Political Science)."

Chadwick plans on continuing the basket auction as an annual event.
