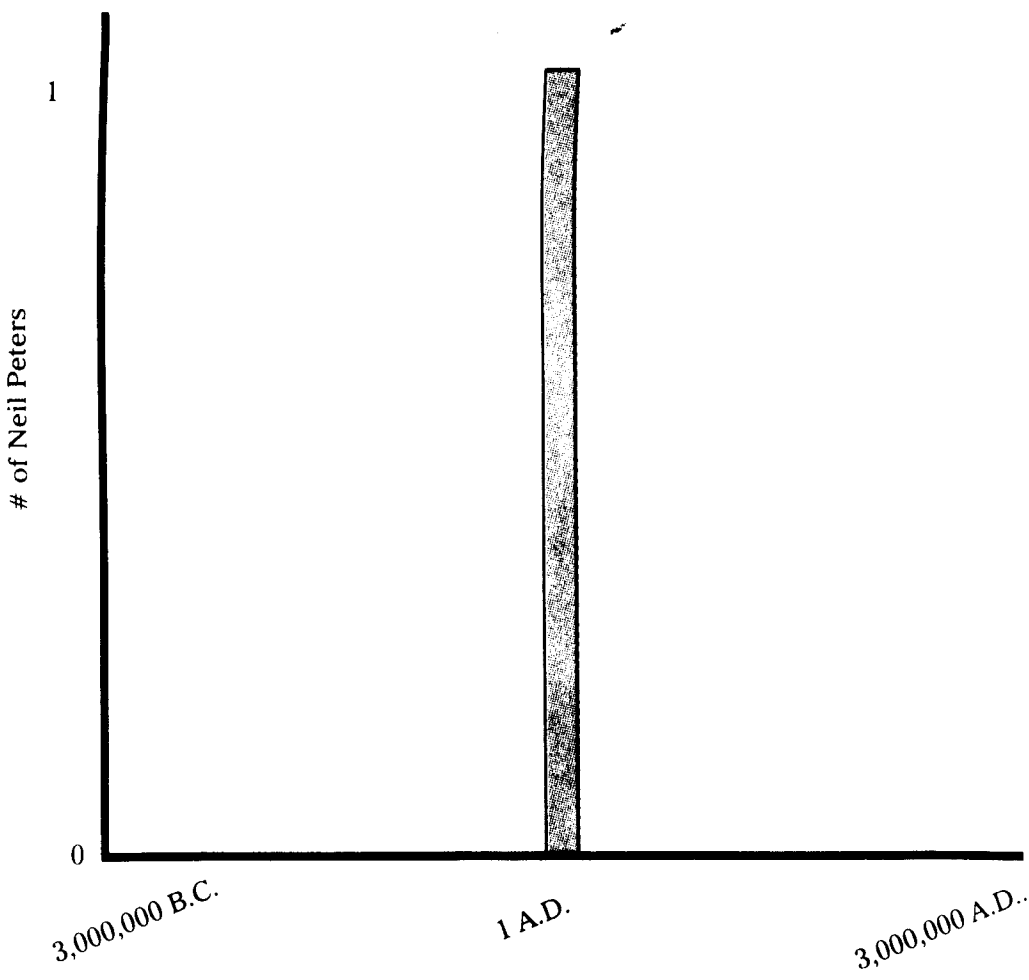
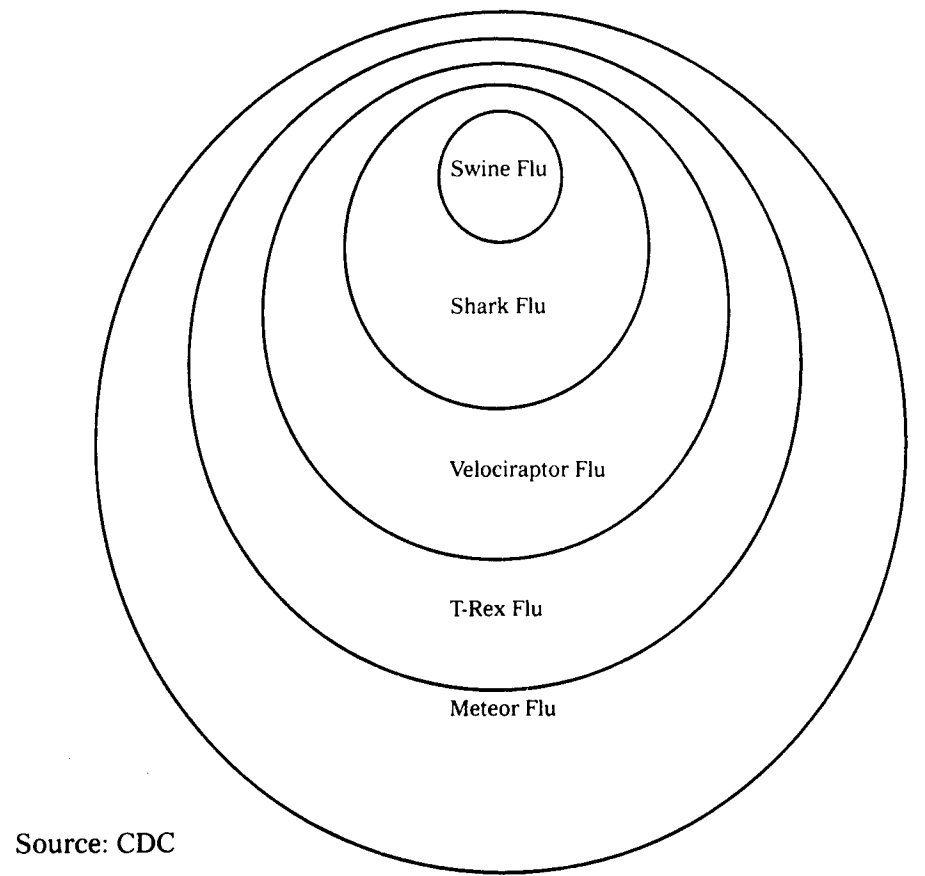


Chart: Varying intensities of influenza viruses
