Not many men were willing to talk about what they learned about testicular cancer, but Autymn Maas mentioned her take on this.

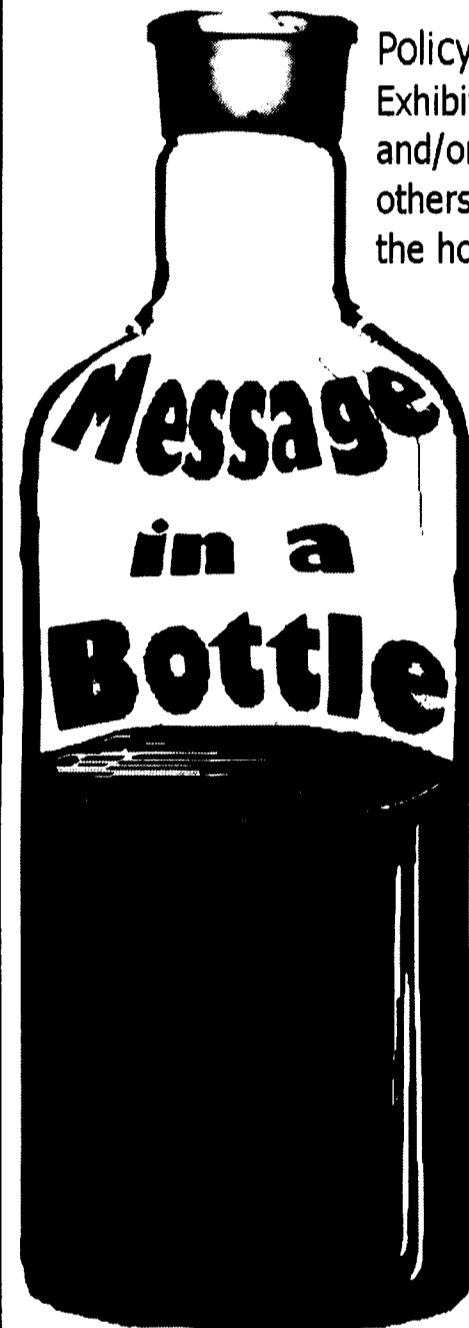
"I had to go and pay special attention to the testicular cancer tables so I could report to all of my guy friends that were too chicken to

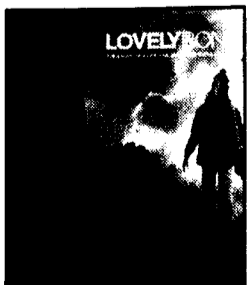
