In accordance with section o-4 of the Senate Regulations, "A student who is absent from a final examination for a cogent reason may have his grade deferred upon the authorization of the 'Director of the Commonwealth Campus at which the student is enrolled).

The Senate Regulations also provide in Section 0-8 that "Any student with two or more final at the same time should file a request for a conflict examination at the time and place specified in advance by the instructor of the course. Any student with three or more examinations on the same day may file a similar request, and conflict examinations will be arranged if feasible.
