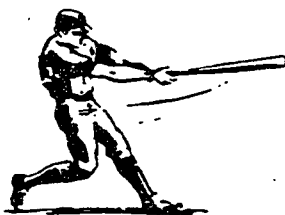


Pictured above is T. Daniels, mimeist, who will be performing April 30 in Erie Hall. He will also be conducting workshops and classes in mime.

The women's softball club opened their season last Saturday with a 11-3 trouncing of Gannon College on a nine strike out performance by Beth Langer. The team travels to Mercyhurst to face the Lakers Thursday. Saturday, the women play the first home game against Allegheny at 4:00 p.m.

Behind the pitching of Al Maki and a no-hit performance by freshman Todd Kresge, the men's varsity baseball team is now 3-2. In an early season, Steve Murawski is leading the team with a .400 batting average (4 for 10). Tom Lawless (.389), Joe McCormick (.357) and Pat Davis (.308) follow closely. The team faced Gannon yesterday, but the results were not available at press time. The next home game is Saturday at one against Point Park College.
