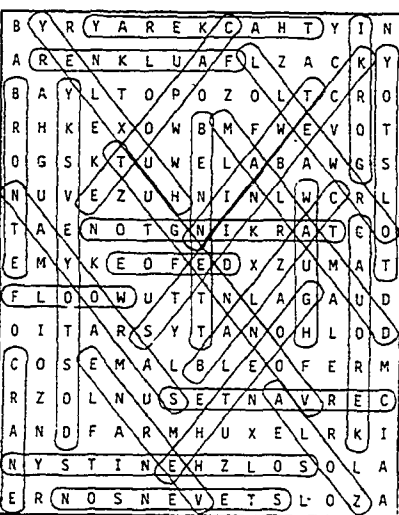
the Pope, while Behrend's Bio-Club saw him quite by accident.
