Ron Williams Named "Athlete of the Year"

Behrend College senior, Ron Williams, was recently selected Cage Classic II Collegiate Athlete of the Year. The award was announced after he played in the Cage Classic II All-Star Tournament held at the Gannon Audi on April 12.

Williams, who will graduate this Spring with a B.S. in Psychology, was selected from among all area collegiate athletes. McDonald's and Youth Creations of Erie joined in presenting Ron with a plaque and a \$500 scholarship in his name

which will be awarded to a deserving player on next year's squad. Athletes were judged on athletic ability, academics, and participation in other school activities.

For four years, the 6'2" guard, played basketball for Behrend, and finished his career as Behrend's third highest all time scorer.

Ron was also selected to the Metro of America All-Tournament Team, and as a NAIA Honorable Mention All American for the 1979-80 season.

After graduation, Ron will be commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the U.S. Army. He will serve his duty as a Field Artillery Officer at Fort Sill Oklahoma.
