

## **Academic Majors:** The Colleges of the University

Undergraduate resident instruction programs are carried out by the ten colleges of the University and the Division of Undergraduate Studies. When students are admitted to bac-calaureate degree programs,

they are given "common year" majors corresponding to their college of enrollment, e.g., Liberal, Arts, Science, etc. Associate degree students are assigned directly to the programs to which they were admitted, and
