Grade Mediation

The purpose of the Grade Mediation Panel is to provide a forum for discussion and resolution when a student and a Behrend College faculty member are involved in a misunderstanding concerning a final grade. Since only the instructor of a given course can give or alter a grade, findings are advisory

The panel is composed of two faculty from the Committee on Undergraduate Studies and two students.

The Grade Mediation Panel is the Third Level Consultation in the following procedure:

First Level Consultation - Student to Faculty Member.
Second Level Consultation -Student to Division Head.

Third Level Consultation - Student to Grade Mediation Panel established by the Undergraduate Studies Committee.

Final Referral-Consultation -

Student to Dean of Faculty.

Any request for remediation must be submitted within one term after the grade has been received. Since the panel meets only during the academic year, complaints concerning grades given spring term will be considered in the fall. sidered in the fall.

The hearing may be during the second academic term, but in no case will the process take more than one academic year. Ques-tions may be directed to the Chairman of the Grade Mediation

I.D. entify

Each student is provided with an ID card at the start of his/her first term at Behrend. At each registration, the ID card is validated with a sticker indicating enrollment for the current term.

This card is to be carried by the student at all times and must be presented to any authorized University official when the student is asked to do so. Students should ask the official to identify himself or herself if there is any doubt as to the individual's
