

Financial Aid

Every student is encouraged to apply for all of the different types of financial aid that are available. (Students who are classified as nondegree are not eligible to receive financial aid). The financial aid programs include:

- STATE GRANTS - Pennsylvania (PHEAA) and other states
- PELL GRANT
- COLLEGE WORK STUDY PROGRAM (CWSP) - employment
- SUPPLEMENTAL EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY GRANT (SEOG)
- NATIONAL DIRECT STUDENT LOAN (NDSL) - low interest loan
- UNIVERSITY LOANS AND ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS
- GUARANTEED STUDENT LOANS

Most of the programs require an early deadline, so watch for information in the Behrend Collegian, on bulletin boards, on the Student Information System, or stop in the Financial Aid Office, second floor, Administration

Bldg. Students receiving Pennsylvania (PHEAA) State Grants are reminded of the PHEAA requirement that they must complete a minimum of 24 credits per year and must be a full-time student (at least 8 credits per term). Financial Aid Deadlines and Dates:

- January - 1983 - Financial Aid Applications available.
- January 1 - First day State Grant and Pell Grant (BEOG) applications may be submitted for financial aid consideration.
- February 15, 1983 - Deadline for filing Pell Grant (BEOG), or FAF if student wishes to be considered for University financial aid.
- March 15, 1983 - Deadline for applying for Pell Grant for the current year.
- March 15, 1983 - Deadline for applying for Summer University aid.
- April 1, 1983 - Deadline for submitting Penn State University Aid Application.
- April 1, 1983 - Deadline for applying for Academic Scholarships.

May 1, 1983 - Deadline for PHEAA applications.

Applications and information concerning financial aid are available in the Financial Aid Office, Second Floor, Administration Building.

Payment and Billing Dates

For matriculated Behrend College students, tuition and charges, including room and board, are due and payable in advance of each term at the Office of the Bursar, 103 Shields Building, University Park, PA 16802. Important dates are as follows:

All tuition and room and board charges must be paid or covered by confirmed financial aid prior to registration.

Students who are eligible for refunds from grants, scholarships, loans, and other financial aid or awards should contact Mr. Richard Sosnowski in the Financial Office, Administration Building, to complete a Refund Request form.

A student who officially withdraws according to University procedure before the end of the term may be eligible to receive a tuition refund on a pro rated basis. According to University regulations, no amount will be refunded for withdrawal after the fourth consecutive calendar week of the term.

It is the responsibility of the student who withdraws from enrollment in courses at Penn State-Behrend to secure appropriate signatures on an official withdrawal form. The official withdrawal may be obtained from the Student Affairs Office. Students who register for classes but decide to withdraw without attending class may complete the University's official withdrawal form.

Important Dates And Deadlines

DATE	ACTIVITY
August 16-20	EARLY REGISTRATION for students who have pre-registered for Fall Term 1982 at Penn State-Behrend. Students who Early Register CANNOT attend regular registration; make changes to pre-registration schedule by DROP/ADD, beginning September 7. First term freshmen are not permitted to Early Register.
August 30, 31 & September 1, 2	PRINT OUT PICK UP for students who pre-registered for Fall Term 1982 at Penn State-Behrend, BUT who will be attending Regular Registration. Print-outs will also be available at Regular Registration.
September 1-2	EVENING SCHOOL REGISTRATION for students registering for ONLY evening coursework. Open 6:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. in the Behrend Building.
September 1, 2	ADVISING DAYS (Wednesday, 1-5 p.m./Thursday, 9-5 p.m.) for students not Early Registered.
September 3	REGULAR REGISTRATION Follow GROUP times as listed on bulletin board outside of Records Office.
September 7	CLASSES BEGIN at 8:00 a.m.
September 16	LATE REGISTRATION AND COURSE ADDITIONS for students either not registered or wishing to add courses to their schedules. NO STUDENT MAY REGISTER FOR A COURSE OR ADD A COURSE AFTER THIS DEADLINE FOR ANY REASON.
September 16	FILE DIPLOMA CARDS by this deadline if you are graduating this Fall. Your diploma may not be printed if card is not received by this deadline. Cards are available in the Records Office.
September 9	PETITIONS TO ENROLL IN MORE THAN 6 CREDITS must be submitted by NXDEG students wishing to do so, along with a supporting memo from the advisor. NO NXDEG STUDENT WILL BE PERMITTED TO REGISTER FOR MORE THAN SIX CREDITS - IF A PETITION IS APPROVED THEN THE STUDENT WILL BE PERMITTED TO ADD COURSES TO HIS/HER SCHEDULE.
September 21	PRE-REGISTRATION FOR UNIVERSITY PARK WINTER TERM forms must be in the Records Office by this deadline to be honored by University Park.
September 23, 24 & 27	PASS/FAIL OPTION forms must be in the Records Office by this deadline. Contact your advisor FIRST to see if you are eligible to take coursework on a pass/fail basis. Senate Rule 49-80.
September 27	REGULAR DROP DEADLINE last day to drop a course and not have it appear on your record.
October 12	DEFERRED GRADE REMOVALS from Spring or Summer must be removed by this deadline. Grades not reported to the Records Office by instructors
October 25-29	PRE-REGISTRATION FOR WINTER TERM 1983 Penn State-Behrend.
November 1	LATE DROP DEADLINE Last day to drop a course. Grade will appear on your records as WP, WF, or WN. NO STUDENT MAY DROP A COURSE AFTER THIS DEADLINE FOR ANY REASON. Senate Rule 34-89. Students are limited to a total of 12 credits LATE DROP if enrolled in a baccalaureate degree or 6 credits LATE DROP if enrolled in an associate degree.
November 15	CLASSES END.
November 16-19	FINAL EXAMS Students should not make advance plans to leave the campus until after the final exam schedule is published.
November 16-19	EARLY REGISTRATION FOR WINTER TERM 1983 AT PENN STATE-BEHREND for students who have pre-registered for Winter Term '83 at Behrend. Students who early register CANNOT attend regular registration; make changes to pre-registration schedules by DROP/ADD beginning December 2.
November 26	LEAVE OF ABSENCE REQUESTS due in Records Office by this deadline.
November 30	ADVISING DAY FOR WINTER TERM.
December 1	REGULAR REGISTRATION FOR WINTER TERM 1983.
