## "Mountain Visions" Slated

Gary Grimm and Katy Flanagan call many places home. Bush cabins in Alaska, sand bars on the Salmon River in Idaho and tents on frigid, wilderness mountain slopes serve as places to hang their hats.

A converted beer truck is home during tours throughout the U.S. and Canada to show their multi-image "concert," MOUNTAIN VISIONS. MOUNTAIN VISIONS is a showcase of the seasons, wild animals, human adventurers, mountains, rivers and sky of the northwest wilderness. Choreographed to varying paces of folk, jazz, bluegrass and synthesized music, the images of backpacking, climbing, whitewater rafting, wilderness skiing and wildlife are splashed onto a 36-foot screen by

nine programmed slide projectors.

Grimm and Flanagan, a husband and wife team, use multi-image productions to "create an effect" by stimulating endless memory images stored in each person's mind with the synchronized photographs of the concert. The couple has also produced SALMON RIVER ODYSSEY, a show of the first descent in open canoes down the "River of No Return" and SOUTH OF DENALI, a production of their ski trek in the Alaska Range. Flanagan uses her dexterity and dancing background to do photographic editing, find musical scores and synchronize the images to music, while Grimm works on conceptual topics in the

photographic production of the programs.

Grimm will be presenting MOUNTAIN VISIONS at Penn State-Behrend's Erie Hall on Thursday, April 5, at 7:00 p.m. The concert is sponsored by the Student Union Board and the Outing Club as part of the Cultural Events Series. Admission will be free and all are invited to share in this uncommon wilderness adventure.


