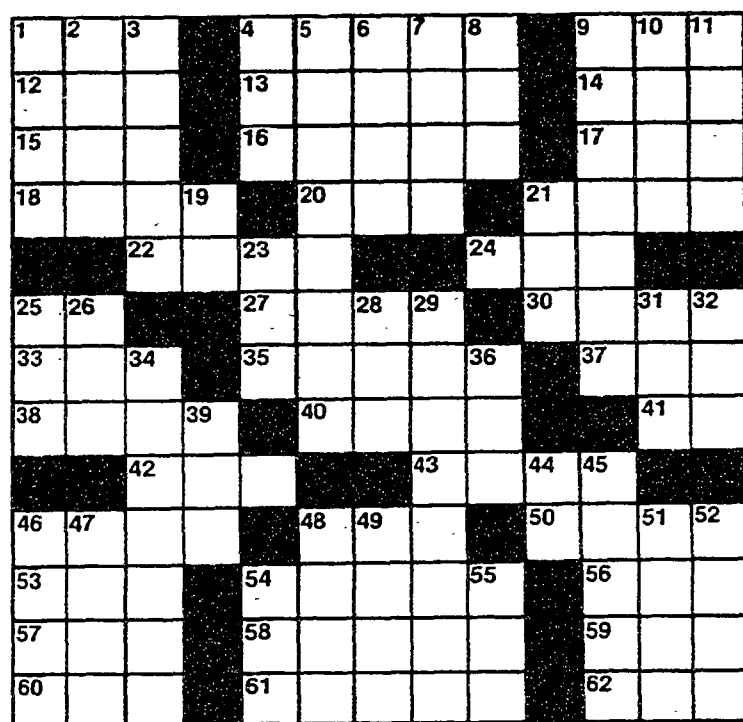
much as possible," Elliot said.

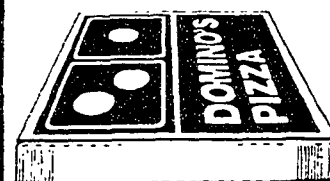
