Lady Cubs Capture Tournament

The Lady Cubs successfully opened its 85-86 campaign by capturing the SUNY-Fredonia Tournament on Nov. 22 and 23. Behrend's women's basketball team defeated host Fredonia in the championship game, 67-43 on Nov. 23.

On Nov. 22 Behrend edged Ithaca College, 55-53 on a jump shot with seven seconds left by junior forward Sue Holmes. Fredonia downed Russell Sage College to advance to the final.

Karen Yurchison, a 5-6 junior guard, was named the tournament's Most Valuable Player. A transfer student from Penn State's Shenango Valley campus, Yurchison scored 13 points against Ithaca and 15 against Fredonia.

Toni Lumley paced the Lady Cubs with 16 points in the championship game and, along with Holmes, was named to the all-tourney squad.

Gannon downs men hoopsters
Behrend's men's team was not as fortunate right out of the gate as they had to face a tough Gan-

non team at the Hammermill Center on Nov. 23 in the 3rd annual Gary Miller Classic.

The Golden Knights, a highly ranked Division II club, had little trouble with Behrend posting a 80-62 victory. High-scorer for the Cubs was junior center Randy Gorniak with 21 points. The 6-8, 225-pounder also pulled down a game-high 12 rebounds.

Teams split home openers

On Nov. 2 both Behrend hoop teams opened their respective seasons at home with the women winning and the men losing a heartbreaker.

The Lady Cubs got things going in Erie Hall by downing Carnegie Mellon, 61-51. Lumley (19 points) and Yurchison (17) led Behrend to its third-straight victory.

Pete Cwalina, the older brother of Behrend forward Paul, banked a shot from the side at the buzzer as Carnegie Mellon nipped the Cubs, 65-63.

Behrend had come back from a 13-point first half deficit and had taken a 62-61 lead with just over two minutes left when sophomore

guard Jim Webb hit a jump shot. Junior guard David Bart led all Tartan scorers with 16 points. Cwalina was one of three other Carnegie Mellon players to score in double figures with 12 points.

Behrend was led again by Gorniak's 17 points and 12 rebounds - both game-highs. Cub guard Gary Manuel added 15 points.
